Chinesische Kinderbildungshilfe (CKH)

Chinesische Kinderbildungshilfe (CKH, means Chinese Children's Aid) is a nonprofit organization founded by Chinese students in Germany, aiming at aiding school children in poor regions in China. The idea originated from a message posted by a Chinese student in a forum in internet, which was soon responded by 10 others from the Ruhr area and Bonn. The basic principle of this organization was established after a meeting of these students in September 2005.

The first members are the first donors. Following the establishment of partnership with a local nonprofit organization in China, the first donation of \notin 400 (about 3700 RMB at the exchange rate of that time) was sent to Guangxi province in south-west China in November 2005. Ten primary school children and six middle school pupils were supported with this money for half a year or one semester. The photos of these children and their letters have been transferred to us from our partner organization and have been presented to the interested. We have answered some of the letters to provide them an emotional support.

Every Euro can make some difference. 20 Euro can support a child in primary school for half a year, same for 40 Euro to a pupil in middle school. We can also help you build up partnership with school children for a continuous support.
